serve students enrolled in SAISD's Bilingual Education/English as a Second Language (ESL) program.

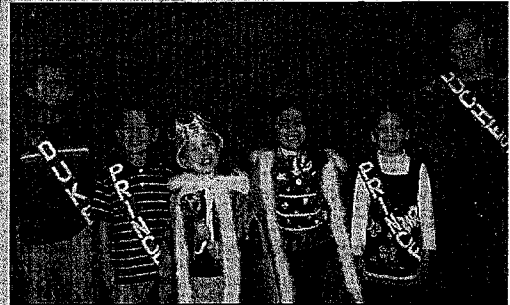

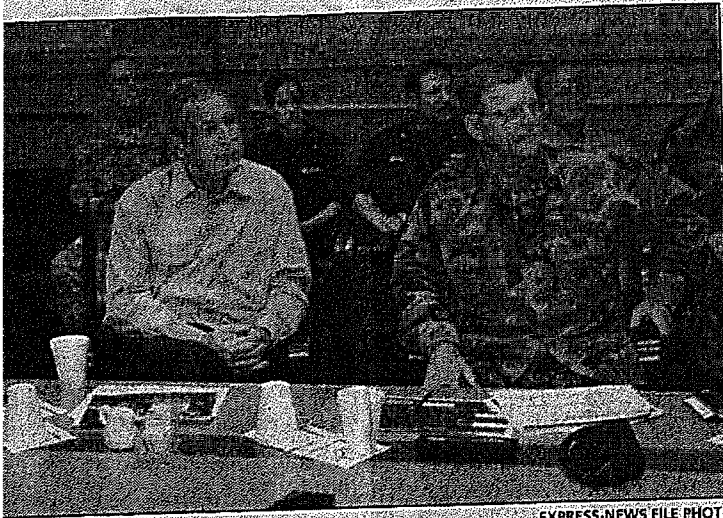

...Years later, his frustration
...with media coverage of the
...case is obvious. Clark thinks
...the media convinced people
...that he and other senior Army
...leaders tolerated the kind of
...abusive behavior that led to
...the killing.

...Today, he doesn't take what
...he reads or views at face
...value.

...“I don't. I don't because of
...my own personal experience
...not just with this but with
...other stories that have been
...published that I've been per-
...sonally familiar with, and that
...runs the gamut from things
...like this to reporting purely
...on military matters that I
...have some insight into. I'll
...just say there's a lot of char-
...acter assassination that went on
...with that that was disconcert-
...ing to say the least.”

...Army man to the bone, born
...into a military family and the
...third generation to wear the
...uniform. Clark, his father and
...grandfathers on both sides of
...the family have at least 139
...years in the Army. That
...doesn't count three of his four
...brothers, who have 55 years in
...the Army and Air Force.

...“I could go into cousins too,
...but you don't have the print
...space,” he laughed.

...Clark has lived on posts 49
...of his 58 years. His father, re-
...tired Col. Harry A. Clark Jr.,
...married his regimental com-
...mander's daughter, and fought
...in World War II and Korea.
...Receiving two Purple Hearts
...for wounds in both conflicts,
...the elder Clark holds two Sil-
...ver Stars, and a Distinguished
...Service Cross. The Silver Star
...and DSC are the nation's
...third- and second highest
...awards for valor, respectively.

...Vietnam was the younger
...Clark's crucible. He arrived
...there in 1971 after being com-
...missioned at Texas Tech. By
...the time he left, only three
...combat brigades would be in
...action.

...“I have to say about my
...Vietnam experience, it was
...the hardest thing,” Clark re-
...called. “It was the hardest
...thing I did in all of my almost
...37 years of service and it is be-
...cause our existence was jung-
...le fighting and living, the mi-
...sery index was very high and
...contacts with the enemy were
...always sudden and violent
...and dramatic.”

...Vietnam was a small-unit
...leader's war. Clark lived in
...the mud with the men he led
...and it was there he learned
...the basics of leadership —
...which began with doing ev-
...erything they did, and espe-
...cially sharing all of their risks
...and hardships.

...His philosophy as a military
...leader — to focus on the mi-
...sion and take care of his sol-
...diers — was shaped by life in
...a filthy, dangerous jungle and
...a series of commanders. He
...said he learned how to deal
...with adversity from several
...men, two of whom endured se-
...rious crises.

...“I saw some of these men go
...through difficult experiences
...and was always impressed
...with their poise and with
...their determination to do the
...right thing,” said Clark, who
...thinks he has kept faith with
...the standards they set. “One
... (officer) used to say, ‘Just re-
...member, they don't pay you to
...be a commander in only the
...good times.’”
