What is a RAB?

A Restoration Advisory Board is an important way the public can be involved in the environmental cleanup at McClellan. RAB members advise the Air Force and regulatory agencies about community concerns and provide comments on McClellan cleanup decisions. The RAB is committed to public outreach and facilitates communication with the community. RAB meetings are open to the public.
