
Public Comment Period on Area of Concern 314 and Potential Release Location S-030A

The Air Force is seeking input on proposed removal actions at two sites impacted by radiological contamination at the former McClellan Air Force Base. These sites are Area of Concern (AOC) 314 (Old Ammunition Storage Area) and Potential Release Location (PRL) S-030A (east of the former paint stripping facility and equipment cleaning wash rack Building 658).

The sites, the radiological contaminants present, the Air Force's proposed removal actions, and all other alternative actions considered are presented in the Area of Concern (AOC) 314 and Potential Release Location (PRL) S-030A Engineering Evaluation/Cost Analysis (EE/CA) for the former McClellan Air Force Base. The EE/CA also summarizes previous site investigations and discusses other cleanup alternatives that were considered. The EE/CA is a

very important step in the cleanup process at McClellan for these sites because it evaluates cleanup alternatives for a non-time critical removal action to remove radium contaminated soil. A Record of Decision (ROD) will be prepared after the removal action to select a final remedy for these sites. This ROD will be completed by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) and is anticipated to be completed in the coming years.

The Air Force and regulatory agencies (U.S. EPA; California Department of Toxic Substance Control; and the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board) encourage you to review the EE/CA and provide written comments during the **public comment period from September 2, 2011 to October 1, 2011**. 


