WHY ARE WE DOING THIS?




- To inform personnel who are engaged in construction and other intrusive activities, as well as stakeholders on or around the former Wurtsmith AFB, about restrictions and deed notices in effect on and adjacent to the former base
- Required in decision documents issued by the Air Force
- Munition awareness training, required by notices that have been placed on specified areas and that are officially recorded with the county



Restricted and Notice Areas







Typical Restrictions



- Groundwater Restriction
- Land Use Restriction (Industrial)
 - Use of land limited to those allowed under Industrial uses as defined in the Oscoda Township and OWAA zoning ordinance
 - No land use change allowed without prior written consent of the Air Force
- **■** Excavation Restriction below 15' (SMEAR ZONE)
- Health & Safety Plan for excavations above 15'
- Contaminated Soil Management (Soil Movement Restriction)
- Maintain Soil Cover
- Excavation Restriction (Prohibited)
- Slab Restrictions
- Munitions and Explosives of Concern (MEC) Notice



UXO-MEC Briefing Objectives



- Learn identification features of MEC potentially encountered at Wurtsmith
- Learn that not every bomb looks like a bomb
- Understand that "practice" does not mean safe
- Learn the Three R's
 - COGNIZE when you may have encountered a munition and that munitions are dangerous.
 - etreat do not approach, touch, move or disturb it, but carefully leave the area.
 - COORT call 911 and advise the police of what you saw and where you saw it.

Retreat and Report



- Do not disturb the item
- Call 911
 - This should put you in touch with the Oscoda Township Police Department (OTPD)
- Describe what you found and where it is
 - The OTPD will notify the Air Force



DO NOT...



- Pick them up
- Put them in your vehicle
- Stick anything into them to see if they are empty
- Disturb Them



Land Use Restrictions Continued



- Be alert for munitions during ground disturbing activity
 - Plowing
 - Digging
 - Trenching
- On-site Explosive Ordnance Disposal (EOD) support required for ground disturbing activities in former weapon storage area
- If the owner or user suspects a munition
 - Remember the 3R's








PFAS RI Update




- PFAS RI UFP-QAPP addendum will be issued the week of 5 June 2023 for concurrent EGLE and public review
 - Addresses additional investigation on the east side of Van Etten Creek and Van Etten Lake
- Resumed fieldwork on 3 April 2023, using a hydraulic profiling tool (HPT) to determine the depth of clay at proposed vertical aquifer sampling locations
- Nature and extent investigation work will continue through the summer and fall



Phases of Field Work in Work Plan







Accelerated RI Field Work



- Accelerated data collection at wastewater treatment plant (WWTP) to advance the focused feasibility study
 - Seep samples
 - Soil borings in seepage beds
- Accelerated data collection at Aircraft Alert Area to support the interim remedial action
 - Vertical aquifer sampling (VAS)





Proposed Soil Boring

Interim Remedial Action Alert Aircraft Area




- 60% Design Drawings: completed
- 90% Design Drawings: complete in May 2023
- Technical meeting between EGLE Water Resources Division (WRD) and Air Force on 27 January 2023 to discuss groundwater infiltration
- EGLE WRD supports groundwater infiltration approach



Three Pipes Ditch Pilot Study Progress



- Access agreement between the Air Force and the USDA Forest Service is in progress
- Flow data will be evaluated from late-May 2023 throughout the summer months
- Flow-through system will be installed during low-flow conditions (to minimize disturbance):
 - Geotextile mat with 1/4-inch layer of Fluoro-Sorb® 400 (organoclay)
 - Filtration tubes (Fluoro-Sorb® 400 and pea gravel) will be placed horizontally across the study area





