

All Property Transferred






Cleanup and Monitoring Requirements

- Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) Hazardous Waste Permit No. 50310
 - Originally issued in 1998 and renewed April 2009
 - Divides the permitted areas into 5 geographic Zones
 - Establishes monitoring at 15 waste management units and Leon Creek
 - In the groundwater, establishes the contaminants of concern (COCs) and Groundwater Protection Standards (GWPSs) or target cleanup levels
 - Establishes groundwater well network to be sampled annually (all units)/semiannually (Resource Conservation and Recovery Act [RCRA] units)
 - Establishes Leon Creek locations to be sampled semiannually






1998 Tetrachloroethene (PCE) Plume Contour






1998 Trichloroethene (TCE) Plume Contour








Tetrachloroethene (PCE) Plume - Effect of Corrective Actions since 1998

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


Trichloroethene (TCE) Plume - Effect of Corrective Actions since 1998






Areas of Optimization Activities

Summary

- Results of cleanup actions since 1998
 - Initial Corrective Actions were effective
 - Reduced source areas
 - Plume areas reduced and stable
 - Effective in stopping contaminants from reaching Leon Creek
- Continued optimization of cleanup actions
 - Address the large dissolved plume areas
 - Reduce time to reach cleanup levels
- Leon Creek monitoring and groundwater monitoring/ optimization activities will continue until cleanup has been completed
- Permit renewal in 2019


