Project Status



Expanded Site Inspection

- Concurrence to proceed to Remedial Investigation received from both USEPA and NHDES in February 2020
- Document final on 13 March 2020 and posted to NHDES OneStop and Air Force Administrative Record

Remedial Investigation

- Preparation of contract documents to begin remedial investigation is underway
- Contract expected to be awarded in Summer 2020
- Flexibility built in to solicit RAB input to RI work plans


Performance-Based Remediation

- Nearing end of 10 year contract for legacy contamination
- Process for replacement contract officially began on 28 Feb 2020 with release of Request for Proposals (RFP); Proposals due 29 Apr 2020

Project Status



- Site 39 (Building 227, Former Pan Am Hangar)
 - In-situ bioremediation began in December 2019 and is on-going
 - Installation of horizontal soil vapor extraction system piping expected to begin in April/May 2020
- Site 49 (2 International Drive)
 - Second round of in-situ bioremediation amendment injections performed in February 2020
- PFOS PFOA Treatment Plants
 - Site 8
 - System offline as of January 2020 as planned to allow for construction
 - Installation of iron pre-treatment system on-going
 - Re-start planned for April 2020

- AIMS

- System online and operating at approximately 600 gallons per minute
- Next performance monitoring scheduled for late March/early April 2020



- NH Fish and Game Update
 - Results distributed to RAB from NH Fish & Game
 - https://www.wildlife.state.nh.us/hunting/deer-liver.html
- 6:2 FTS and other PFAS
 - Lab results contain data for 13 compounds routinely found at Pease;
 AF retains data
 - CERCLA process will be used to incorporate new toxicity information that becomes available for additional PFAS
- New Hampshire SB257
 - Law contains exclusions for military use
 - Department of Defense issued memo in January 2020 on use/spill reporting for all DOD units including National Guard
- CERCLA Definition of "Site"
