

Air Force seeking applicants for membership on the former Pease AFB Restoration Advisory Board

The Air Force Civil Engineer Center is seeking applicants to serve as community members on the Restoration Advisory Board (RAB) at the former Pease Air Force Base, New Hampshire.

Vacant community member seats are open on the RAB and applications are being accepted through January 24, 2022.

Pease RAB community members serve 2-year renewable terms and meet quarterly with the Air Force, regulatory agencies, and other local representatives during these meetings. Informal meetings are also coordinated as needed.

The RAB's purpose is to foster an open dialogue about environmental restoration activities on the former base and within the Portsmouth and Newington communities. Local citizens on the RAB can get involved in the Air Force's on-going cleanup effort and provide advice to decision-makers. The Pease RAB was established in 2016 and continues to be an important forum for community input.

RAB community membership is limited to individuals who live or work on, or near Pease, or are affected by the installation's environmental restoration program.
