  - DAF and EGLE conceptual site models assessments
    - Both assessments indicated that groundwater does not flow under Van Ettel Lake to east side
  - Newly established Technical Working Group (TWG)
- TWG kickoff meeting scheduled for 28 Aug
  - Community RAB selects TWG representatives during RAB meeting



## BRAC Cleanup Team (BCT) Update



- Jul 2025 BCT meeting summary
  - DAF and EGLE conceptual site models assessments
    - Both assessments indicated that groundwater does not flow under Van Ettel Lake to east side
  - Discussed the responses to EGLE comments on the Draft Final 2024
     Long Term Monitoring Report
  - Discussed EGLE comments on the 2023 Pump and Treat Systems Report
  - Minutes and meeting materials will be put in Oscoda library and on the Admin Record when finalized



- Alert Aircraft Area IRA operational in late Jan
  - Plan to conduct performance review after 12 months of operation
  - Consistent with other IRA treatment systems
- 3 pipes stormwater joint sealing NTCRA funded and required documentation under development with Oscoda Township
- 3 pipes source area IRA and WWTP IRA design contract award by 30 Sep
  - Forward funded IRA construction for 3 pipes source area this year
- PFAS RI data gap contract award by 30 Sep



#### FY26 Planned Activities




- Complete the PFAS UFP-QAPP addendum and start fieldwork
- Complete design for sites DRMO and LF030/031 IRAs
- Complete joint sealing for 1,800 feet of 3 pipes stormwater system
- Complete pre-design investigation to support final design for 3 pipes source area IRA
- Complete pre-design investigation to support final design for WWTP IRA
  - Postured WWTP IRA construction funding in FY26






- Revise Draft Preliminary Characterization Summary Report under DAF review

- Pre-design field investigation nearly complete






## Short Range Forecast 3-Pipes Stormwater Pipe NTCRA

THE COURT MODIFIED COLUMN


- DAF planning a non-time critical removal action (NTCRA) to seal the stormwater pipe joints for approx. 1,800 ft of 72-inch diameter pipe where PFAS-impacted groundwater enters
- NTCRA requires an engineering evaluation/cost analysis (EE/CA), public comment period, and action memorandum
  - DAF reviewing draft EE/CA






## Short Range Forecast 3-Pipes Stormwater Pipe NTCRA

- Oscoda Township owns stormwater pipe so Environmental Services Agreement (ESA) required
  - DAF addressing Township comments on draft ESA
  - Township contracts for sealing, DAF pays the cost





- Critical process analysis (CPA) recommended source area IRA
  - Foam fractionation system to remove PFAS from groundwater
- Work is progressing on schedule






## Long Range Forecast Mastewater Treatment Plant IRA

#### **■ CPA recommended IRA**

- Horizontal reactive treatment wells to remove PFAS from groundwater
- Work progressing on schedule
