## 2017 Article Submission Deadlines

Spring Issue – Feb. 22, 2017 Summer Issue – May 3, 2017 Fall Issue – Jul. 31, 2017 Winter Issue – CE Almanac, submissions are not accepted

**NOTE:** Magazine staff will edit submissions for clarity, adherence to Associated Press Style, grammar, and length. Please be aware that all submissions may not be published in print or on CE Online.

## CE Magazine Image Guidelines

We encourage you to send an image to accompany your CE Magazine submission. Including a high quality image with your submission will help engage our readers. Please review and adhere to the following image submission guidelines. If images that are submitted do not meet these requirements, they cannot be used.

- Images that accompany articles should be sent as separate attachments
- At minimum, images should be 300 dpi (dots per inch), 1MG or larger, 3x5 inches, and a JPEG file. The dpi of an image can be checked by right clicking on the image, selecting "properties," and selecting "details"
- Include an image credit: (Title, First Name, Last Name)
- Include a brief description of the image written in a complete sentence that relates the image to the article
- Include metadata: City, State, and Country of where the image was taken

Please write the body of the CE Magazine article in this space. See the CE Magazine article writing guidelines below:

- Theme Article: An article in alignment with the CE Magazine Issue theme (500 1,000 words)
- **Feature Article:** A limited number of articles on general topics such as energy, environmental, career development, research and technology (500 600 words)
- Articles submitted in MS Word document, single spaced, Calibri, size 11
- Adhere to Associated Press Style. For example:
  - o Include a single space after each sentence
  - o All acronyms should be spelled out the first time within the article
  - No series commas
  - o Titles are written as Lt. Col. instead of Lt Col.
  - o Dates should be written as Month Day, Year
- Editor's Note: An about-the-author note may be included at the end of the article and include information such as duty title and/or professional titles or credentials. Any additional authors can be included. All author information should include name, duty title, and organization (e.g., John Smith is the program manager for the Directorate of Civil Engineers).
