Air Force Fire Emergency Services makes every dollar count!

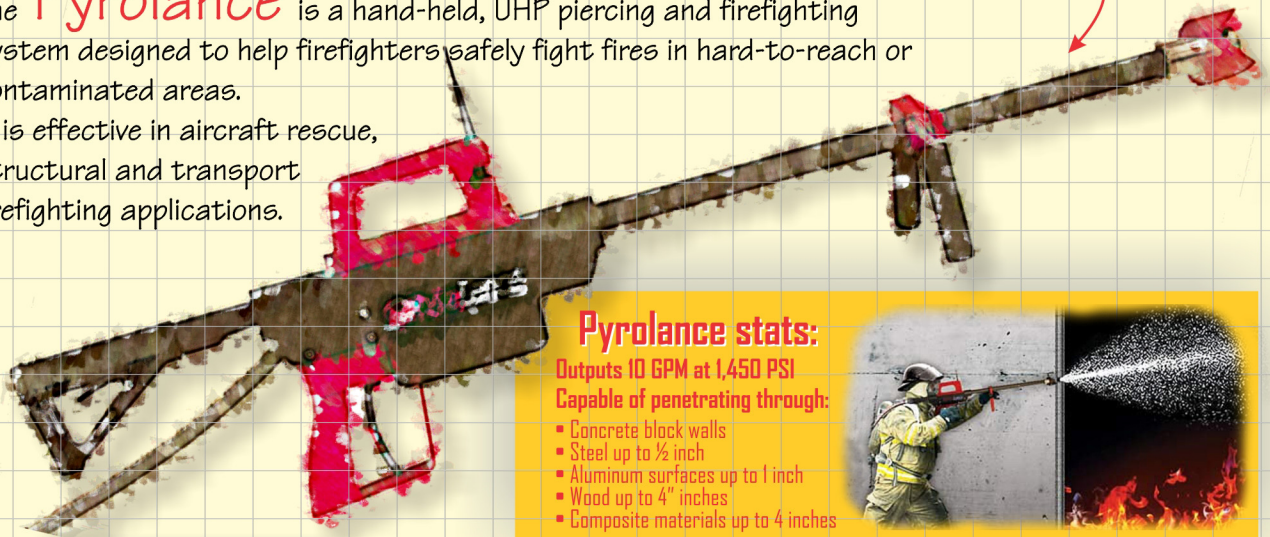
The Fire Emergency Services Division of the Air Force Civil Engineer Center has earned more than **\$323 million in actual cost savings and cost avoidance** for the Air Force.

Here are some of the ways they did it!

Bulk Purchasing

The FES team uses bulk purchasing power to keep costs down while improving firefighting tools.

The **Pyrolance** is a hand-held, UHP piercing and firefighting system designed to help firefighters safely fight fires in hard-to-reach or contaminated areas. It is effective in aircraft rescue, structural and transport firefighting applications.



Pyrolance stats:

Outputs 10 GPM at 1,450 PSI
Capable of penetrating through:

- Concrete block walls
- Steel up to ½ inch
- Aluminum surfaces up to 1 inch
- Wood up to 4" inches
- Composite materials up to 4 inches



\$SAVINGS\$:

Without a volume discount the Pyrolance system was \$34,900.

By negotiating a bulk purchasing cost on 212 units, the Air Force saved \$2,400 per unit.

Total Air Force savings is \$508,800!
